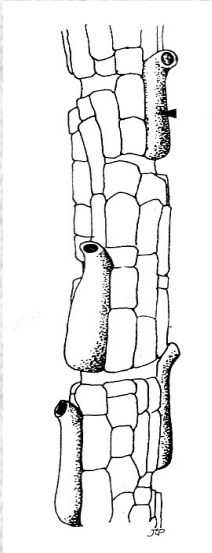

Peat moss tubular structure.

Peat moss is the accumulation of decomposing sphagnum plants found where the land was once covered with water.

After thousands of years a dense layer of decomposed plant material formed what today we call bogs.

The large cell structure of Peat Moss, enables it to absorb air and water like a sponge capable of storing huge quantities of liquid (20 times its weight!).

In addition, peat moss naturally suppresses the development and propagation of certain harmful bacteria. Using peat moss litter makes animals more comfortable, healthy and consequently, more productive.

Composted peat moss is easily spread. What's more, it retains nutrients such as nitrogen and phosphorous which become valuable nutrition for the soil.
